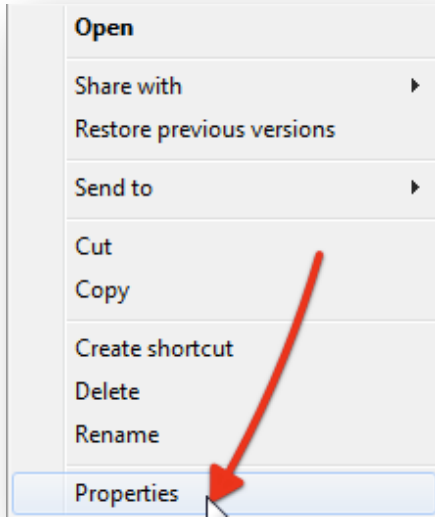
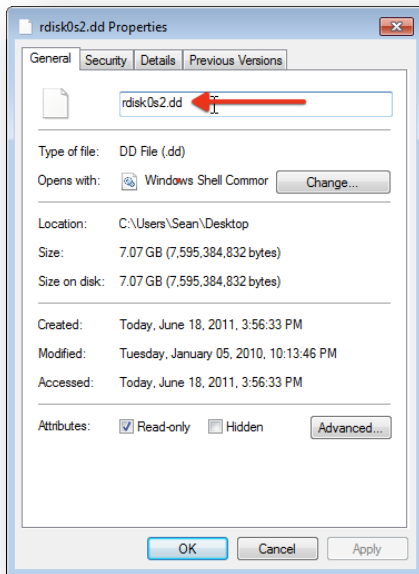


Lantern and Mobile Phone Examiner's iDevice Images

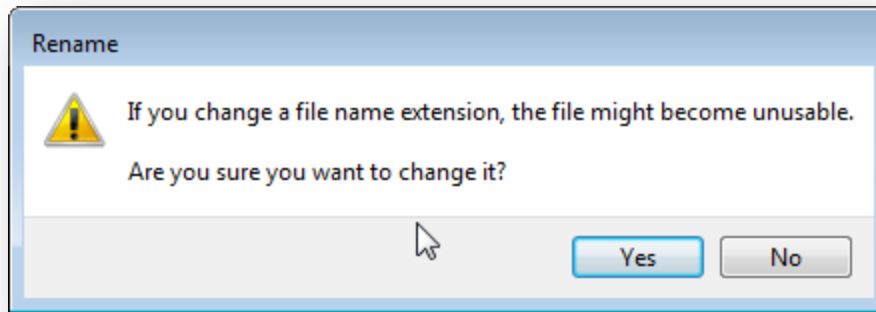
1. From your Bootcamp Windows operating system, navigate to where you saved your image.
2. Right click on the image and select properties,



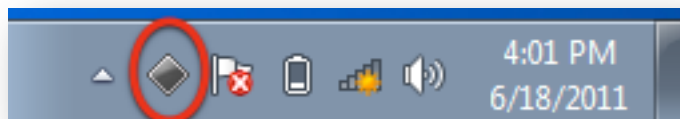
3. From the General tab, change the filename from [filename].dd to [filename].dmg



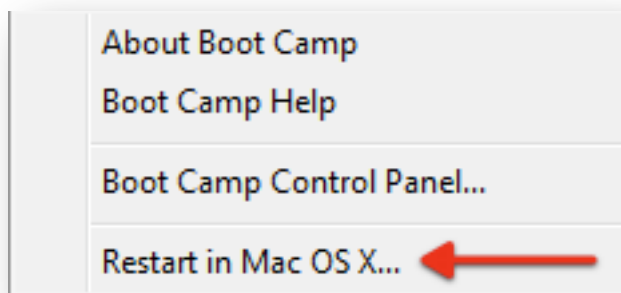
4. A warning message will appear and select, "Yes" to complete the change.



5. Next restart into OS X. From the task bar on the far right is a black diamond icon,



6. Click on the icon and select restarting into OS X.

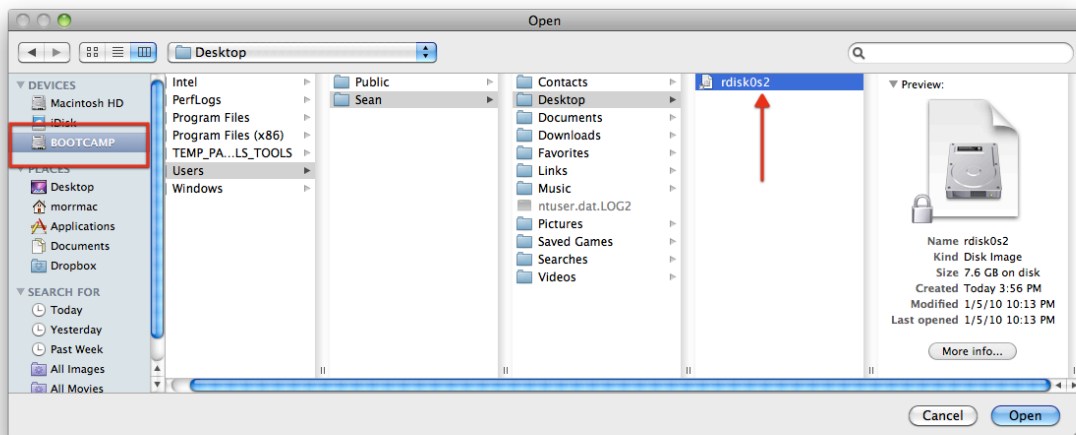


From OS X bringing the image is easy. OS X can read from NTFS formatted drives but cannot write to them without the assistance of third party software. Therefore this becomes an instant write blocker. To add a MPE+ image into Lantern, follow the following steps.

1. Start Lantern
2. Create a New case
3. Select acquire from the top menu
4. From the acquisition menu, select disk image.



5. From the Finder window, the Mac can read files from the Bootcamp partition. Navigate to your image that is on the Windows partition as seen below, and select open.



6. Then select "Everything" and Lantern will begin processing the image. Then review the artifacts.
